STATE OF EMERGENCY
Tropical Storm Helene

WHEREAS, Nick Biondo, Chairman of the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Greater Naples Fire Rescue District is authorized pursuant to the authority establishing the Fire Rescue District known as the Greater Naples Fire Rescue District, as covered by Chapter 2014-240 Laws of Florida, to declare a Local State of Emergency due to the current and predicted path of Tropical Storm Helene.

WHEREAS, the Governor of Florida, Ron DeSantis, has issued Executive Order number 24-209 effective September 24, 2024 declaring a state of emergency in several counties in the State of Florida including Collier County.

WHEREAS, the declaration is a proactive measure to allow the District to be prepared for any unforeseen expenditures due to the storm and to use the Districts' emergency operations plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the State of Emergency for the said District shall be effective September 24, 2024, and continue until such time it is declared otherwise.

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution will be recorded in the next regularly scheduled Board meeting minutes of the Greater Naples Fire Rescue District.
