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- Injury Report (11-16-23): Unavoidable; request Life Scan to report any injuries to HR.
- Injury Report (11-21-23): Avoidable; wear proper PPE – extrication gloves.
- Injury Report (11-27-23): Avoidable; when at night use a flashlight.
- Accident Report (11-28-23): Avoidable; situational awareness.
- Accident Report (12-3-23): Unavoidable; take the appropriate apparatus per policy.
- Exposure Report (12-4-23): Unavoidable; wear proper PPE, require to get TB test.
- Injury Report (12-21-23): Unavoidable.
- Exposure Report (12-22-23): Undetermined; Krajewski will follow up with Greaves/damage report; keep for next review.
- Exposure Report (12-23-23): Unavoidable; work on proper DECON for staff.
- Exposure Report (12-25-23): Unavoidable.
