- Injury Report 7-31-23: Avoidable; Recommendation make sure SCBA mask is in a clean state.
- Injury Report 8-30-23: Unavoidable; No Recommendation



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- Injury Report 9-3-23: Undetermined- use proper mechanics; Recommendation for videos and EPR for proper lifting techniques and look into personal training for the District.
- Vehicle Accident 9-7-23: Unavoidable; No recommendations due to the nature of the incident.
- Injury Report 9-6-23: Avoidable; Recommendation to use the tool the proper way.
- Vehicle Accident 8-12-23: Avoidable; Don't use District vehicle while off duty and situational awareness.
- Exposure Report 8-18-23: Avoidable; Wear proper PPE, don't allow patients to smoke while interacting.
- Exposure Report 8-18-23: Avoidable; Wear proper PPE, don't allow patients to smoke while interacting.
- Exposure Report 8-24-23: Unavoidable; Wear proper PPE and situational awareness.
