## JOINT FEDERAL, STATE, LOCAL PUBLIC NOTICE January 21, 2025

The Greater Naples Fire Rescue District intends to submit an application for the Rebuild Florida Hazard Mitigation Grant Match Program (HMGMP). The HMGMP program utilizes match funding from the FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) through the Florida Division of Emergency Management and HUD Community Development Block Grant - Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) match funding through Florida Commerce. Funding for the proposed project will be conditional upon compliance with all applicable federal, tribal, state and local laws, regulations, floodplain standards, permit requirements and conditions.

The Fire District is seeking a total of \$3,992,489 to perform a wind retrofit on six fire stations. Fire stations 20, 22, 71, 72, 73, and 90 are vital to the community and provide protection of life and property by providing emergency response services. The project shall harden the exterior envelopes of the six (6) fire stations, reducing the potential for structural and content damages from future wind events.
